## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Article 2 of Chapter 4 of Title 3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, 1 2 relating to state license requirements and regulations for manufacture, distribution, and 3 package sales, so as to provide for the issuance of a manufacturer's or distiller's license to a 4 fruit grower for the manufacture of distilled spirits under certain circumstances; to provide 5 for the issuance of a manufacturer's or distiller's license authorizing the manufacture of 6 distilled spirits from agricultural products other than perishable fruits grown in this state 7 under certain circumstances; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and 8 for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

## **SECTION 1.**

Article 2 of Chapter 4 of Title 3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to state license requirements and regulations for manufacture, distribution, and package sales, is amended by revising Code Section 3-4-24, relating to the issuance to fruit growers of license to manufacture distilled spirits, storage and disposition, limitations upon manufacture and sale, issuance of manufacturer's or distiller's license in certain counties or municipalities, as follows:

17 *"*3-4-24.

(a) The commissioner may issue a license to a fruit grower authorizing the grower tomanufacture distilled spirits from perishable fruits grown in this state.

(b) If any distilled spirits are manufactured as permitted by this Code section in any
county, municipality, or county area exclusive of certain incorporated areas, as the case
may be, in which the distilled spirits are not to be sold under the terms of this chapter, the
licensee shall immediately store the distilled spirits or alcohol in a warehouse or
warehouses designated by the commissioner to be sold or disposed of under the supervision
of the commissioner in states, counties, or municipalities permitting the legal sale of
distilled spirits or alcohol.

27	(c) It is unlawful for the licensee to sell or dispose of any such distilled spirits or alcohol:
28	(1) In any municipality, county, or unincorporated area of a county in which the sale of
29	distilled spirits or alcohol is prohibited by this chapter; or
30	(2) To any person not holding a wholesale or retail license issued pursuant to this
31	chapter.
32	(d) No <u>A</u> manufacturer's or distiller's license shall <u>may</u> be issued pursuant to this Code
33	section to a fruit grower for the manufacture of distilled spirits in any county or
34	municipality of this state that has not approved either the package sale of distilled spirits
35	or the sale of distilled spirits by the drink, or both, as provided in this chapter."
36	SECTION 2.
37	Said article is further amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
38	<u>3-4-24.1.</u>
39	(a) The commissioner may issue a license authorizing the manufacture of distilled spirits
40	from agricultural products other than perishable fruits grown in this state.
41	(b) If any distilled spirits are manufactured as permitted by this Code section in any
42	county, municipality, or county area exclusive of certain incorporated areas, as the case
43	may be, in which the distilled spirits are not to be sold under the terms of this chapter, the
44	licensee shall immediately store the distilled spirits or alcohol in a warehouse or
45	warehouses designated by the commissioner to be sold or disposed of under the supervision
46	of the commissioner in states, counties, or municipalities permitting the legal sale of
47	distilled spirits or alcohol.
48	(c) It is unlawful for the licensee to sell or dispose of any such distilled spirits or alcohol:
49	(1) In any municipality, county, or unincorporated area of a county in which the sale of
50	distilled spirits or alcohol is prohibited by this chapter; or
51	(2) To any person not holding a wholesale or retail license issued pursuant to this
52	chapter.
53	(d) A manufacturer's or distiller's license may be issued pursuant to this Code section for
54	the manufacture of distilled spirits from agricultural products other than perishable fruits
55	in any county or municipality of this state that has approved either the package sale of
56	distilled spirits or the sale of distilled spirits by the drink, or both, as provided in this
57	<u>chapter.</u>
58	(e) A manufacturer or distiller issued a license pursuant to this Code section may provide
59	promotional tours, but shall not provide tastings or samplings of distilled spirits at any
60	<u>time."</u>
