A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act to create a board of elections and registration for Paulding County and to
2 provide for its powers and duties, approved May 30, 2007 (Ga. L. 2007, p. 4382), so as to
3 provide for staggered terms of office for members of the board; to provide for related
4 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 1.**

7 An Act to create a board of elections and registration for Paulding County and to provide for
8 its powers and duties, approved May 30, 2007 (Ga. L. 2007, p. 4382), is amended by revising
9 subsection (f) of Section 3 of the Act as follows:

10 "(f)(1) The initial appointees to the board shall take office on July 1, 2007. Each initial
11 member shall serve a term of office beginning on July 1, 2007, and ending on June 30,
12 2011.

13 (2) The members of the board who are appointed to take office on July 1, 2011, and their
14 successors shall be appointed as provided in this paragraph. Two of the members
15 appointed pursuant to subsection (b) of this section to take office on July 1, 2011, shall
16 serve two-year terms of office and until their respective successors are appointed and
17 qualified. The other member appointed pursuant to subsection (b) of this section to take
18 office on July 1, 2011, shall serve a four-year term of office and until his or her successor
19 is appointed and qualified. The board of commissioners shall designate which appointees
20 shall serve two-year terms and which appointee shall serve a four-year term when making
21 such appointments. The members appointed pursuant to subsections (c) and (d) of this
22 section to take office on July 1, 2011, shall serve four-year terms of office and until their
23 respective successors are appointed and qualified.

24 (3) Successors to the members appointed pursuant to paragraph (2) of this subsection
25 shall be appointed to serve four-year terms of office and until their respective successors
26 are appointed and qualified."
