## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 2 of Chapter 5 of Title 14, Code Section 27-1-13, and Code Section 52-7-5
- 2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to, respectively, corporation
- 3 commissioner, disposition of funds received by the Department of Natural Resources,
- 4 appropriations, and grants and donations for natural resources conservation camps, and
- 5 numbering of watercraft vessels, so as to provide for refunding of fees under certain
- 6 circumstances; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 7 purposes.

## 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 **SECTION 1.** 

- 10 Article 2 of Chapter 5 of Title 14 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 11 corporation commissioner, is amended by revising Code Section 14-5-21, relating to fees and
- 12 reports, as follows:
- 13 "14-5-21.
- All fees collected by the Secretary of State shall be paid into the state treasury for the use
- of the state, and the Secretary of State shall include in his or her annual reports a full
- statement of all fees collected or received under Chapters 2 through 5 of this title and the
- disposition thereof. The Secretary of State shall be authorized to establish, by rule or
- regulation, a procedure by which his or her office shall refund fees collected in error or
- 19 overpayment or to which the state is otherwise not entitled."

SECTION 2.

- 21 Code Section 27-1-13 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to disposition of
- 22 funds received by the Department of Natural Resources, appropriations, and grants and
- 23 donations for natural resources conservation camps, is amended by revising subsection (a)
- 24 as follows:

26 "(a) All funds resulting from the operation of the department and from the administration 26 of the laws and regulations pertaining to wildlife, excluding fines, but including all license 27 fees and other income (except that income provided for in subsection (b) of this Code 28 section), shall be paid into the general funds of the state treasury; and each year at least 29 such amount shall be appropriated to the department. The department shall be authorized 30 to establish, by rule or regulation, a procedure to refund fees collected in error or 31 overpayment or to which the department or state is otherwise not entitled."

32 SECTION 3.

- 33 Code Section 52-7-5 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to numbering of
- 34 watercraft vessels, is amended by adding a new subsection to read as follows:
- 35 "(o) The department shall be authorized to establish, by rule or regulation, a procedure to
- 36 refund fees collected pursuant to this chapter which were collected in error or overpayment
- 37 or to which the department or state is otherwise not entitled."

SECTION 4.

39 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
