A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the Augusta State University men's golf team on winning the 2010 NCAA
2 Division I National Championship; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, through perseverance and iron determination, the Augusta State University
4 men's golf team earned national acclaim by winning the 2010 NCAA Division I Men's Golf
5 Championship held at The Honors Course in Ooltewah, Tennessee; and

6 WHEREAS, the Jaguars entered the national tournament ranked fifth in the nation and
7 proceeded to defeat the number three seed the Georgia Institute of Technology, number two
8 Florida State University, and the number one seed Oklahoma State; and

9 WHEREAS, this amazing accomplishment is the first national title in men's golf for Augusta

17 WHEREAS, the astute direction and confidence of Head Coach Josh Gregory led the team
18 to a successful and record-breaking season; and

19 WHEREAS, in addition to their triumphs on the golf course, the team's grade point average
20 for the 2009-2010 academic year was 3.2; and

21 WHEREAS, as this magnificent team earned its well-deserved reputation for excellence by
22 performing with courage and precision over months of training and competition, it is
23 abundantly proper to call them champions.
