A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 14 of Title 10 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, the "Georgia
- 2 Cemetery and Funeral Services Act of 2000," so as to provide that preneed escrow accounts
- 3 may be titled in the name of and made payable in favor of an entity registered to provide
- 4 preneed services upon the death of the purchaser; to provide for related matters; to provide
- 5 an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7	SECTION 1.

- 8 Chapter 14 of Title 10 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, the "Georgia Cemetery
- 9 and Funeral Services Act of 2000," is amended by revising Code Section 10-14-7, relating
- 10 to preneed escrow accounts, by adding a new subsection to read as follows:
- 11 <u>"(c.1) Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary contained in Chapter 1 of Title 7, the</u>
- 12 <u>'Financial Institutions Code of Georgia,' or in any other provision of law, any funds</u>
- deposited with a depository institution in accordance with this Code section may be placed
- in a preneed escrow account that is:
- 15 (1) Titled in the name of an entity registered under this chapter to provide preneed
- 16 <u>services;</u>
- 17 (2) Payable upon the death of the purchaser in favor of an entity registered under this
- chapter to provide preneed services; or
- 19 (3) Titled in the name of an entity registered under this chapter to provide preneed
- 20 <u>services and payable upon the death of the purchaser in favor of an entity registered under</u>
- 21 <u>this chapter to provide preneed services.</u>
- 22 The preneed escrow account shall be established and maintained subject to the funding and
- 23 <u>filing requirements set forth in this chapter.</u>"
