A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Colonel Benjamin Jefferson Hulsey III on the occasion of his
2 retirement; and for other purposes.

18 something greater than himself, and his decades of service as a guardian of this nation's
19 freedom and liberty are worthy of recognition.

21 commend Colonel Benjamin Jefferson Hulsey III for his efficient, effective, unselfish, and
22 dedicated public service to the citizens of his country; congratulate him upon the grand
