

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO INTRODUCE LOCAL LEGISLATION

Notice is given that there will be introduced at the regular 2011 session of the General Assembly of Georgia a bill to amend an Act completely revising the laws relative to the governing authority of Chatham County, approved March 29, 1984 (GA. L. 1984, p. 5050), as amended, particularly by an Act approved March 30, 1990 (GA. L. 1990, p. 3992), so as to remove the term limitations of the office of chairperson; to conform the residency requirement for chairperson to general law; to provide for related matters; to provide a referendum; to provide for effective dates and automatic repeal; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.
