A RESOLUTION

11 great leadership skills and initiative during his years with the Boy Scouts of America
12 program; and
- 13 WHEREAS, to earn the rank of Eagle Scout, Bruce constructed six raised garden beds for
14 the St. Bede's Episcopal Church Community Garden in Atlanta; and
- 15 WHEREAS, an outstanding Georgian, Bruce has truly exhibited a commitment to the
16 scouting principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a
17 manner becoming an Eagle Scout; and
- 18 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader
19 is an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young man's future.
- 20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
21 commend Scott Bruce Lampros for his diligence and dedication in pursuing the highest

22 honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on attaining the
23 prestigious rank of Eagle Scout.
