A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Mrs. Ashley Jenkins on her outstanding public service; and
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mrs. Ashley Jenkins has long been recognized by the citizens of this state for
4 the vital role that she has played in leadership and her deep personal commitment to the
5 welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, she has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of her time,
7 talents, and energy toward the betterment of her community and state as evidenced
8 dramatically by her superlative service for the past six years with the Sandy Springs City
9 Council; and

10 WHEREAS, a native of St. Simons Island, Georgia, Mrs. Jenkins earned a bachelor's degree
11 from the University of Georgia and a law degree from George Mason University; and

12 WHEREAS, during her tenure with the Sandy Springs City Council, Mrs. Jenkins has been
13 instrumental in the incorporation of Sandy Springs, led the fight to reduce business and
14 occupational taxes, and helped improve safety for students with the Sidewalks to Schools

17 expanded the gymnastic program at Hammond Park, pushed for renovations to the Morgan
18 Falls ballfields, developed a new play structure for Hammond Park, assisted in the creation

21 WHEREAS, Mrs. Jenkins's significant organizational and leadership talents, her remarkable
22 patience and diplomacy, her keen sense of vision, and her sensitivity to the needs of the

23 citizens of this state have earned her the respect and admiration of her colleagues and
24 associates; and

25 WHEREAS, she is united in love and marriage to her husband, Mike, and has been blessed
26 with two remarkable children, Peyton and Will; and

27 WHEREAS, Mrs. Jenkins has served with honor and distinction with the Sandy Springs City
28 Council and her vision and unyielding commitment have set the standard for public service;

31 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
