5 Elementary School and graduated from Ware County High School; and

6 WHEREAS, he entered the service on March 21, 1966, and was killed by a sniper in the line

7 of fire on April 26, 1967, while proudly serving our country in Company C., 39th Infantry,

8 9th Infantry Division, deployed in Vietnam; and

9 WHEREAS, Sergeant Bagley served his county with honor and distinction and received a

10 Bronze Star with "V" for Valor, a Purple Heart, and a Combat Infantryman badge; and

11 WHEREAS, his two surviving brothers and their wives, Roy and Susie Bagley of Odum,

12 Georgia, and Jimmy and Willodene Bagley of Telmore, Georgia, wish to honor the memory

13 of their fallen brother; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Ware County owe a deep debt of gratitude to Sergeant Bagleyfor his ultimate sacrifice and wish to honor him for the same; and

WHEREAS, it is only fitting and proper that a lasting memorial to this American hero beestablished.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 19 GEORGIA that the members of this body join in recognizing and honoring Sergeant Jerry 20 Bagley for his heroic actions and unselfish dedication to duty in the service of his country 21 and dedicate the Satilla River Bridge on SR 158 as the Sergeant Jerry Bagley Memorial 22 Bridge.
