A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 40-14-1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, containing
2 definitions relative to speed detection devices, so as to allow certain rehabilitation centers to
3 obtain permits for using such devices; to provide for related matters; to provide for an
4 effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 1.**

7 Code Section 40-14-1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, containing definitions
8 relative to speed detection devices, is revised as follows:

9 "40-14-1.

10 As used in this chapter, the term:

11 (1) 'Campus' means the grounds owned or occupied by a college or university.

12 (2) 'Campus law enforcement agency' means the campus agency charged with the
13 enforcement of the laws of this state.

14 (3) 'College or university' means an accredited public or private educational institution
15 of higher learning. College or university shall also include any comprehensive
16 rehabilitation center in this state dedicated to technological advancement, research
17 opportunities, continuing education, and future development on behalf of persons with
18 disabilities.

19 (4) 'Speed detection device' means, unless otherwise indicated, that particular device
20 designed to measure the speed or velocity of a motor vehicle and marketed under the
21 name 'Vascar' or any similar device operating under the same or similar principle and any
22 devices for the measurement of speed or velocity based upon the Doppler principle of
23 radar or the speed timing principle of laser. All such devices ~~must~~ shall meet or exceed
24 the minimum performance specifications established by the Department of Public Safety."

25 **SECTION 2.**

26 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2011.

27 **SECTION 3.**

28 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
