A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Reverend Dr. Walter L. Glover, Jr.; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Reverend Dr. Walter L. Glover, Jr., has demonstrated a commitment to teaching
3 the Gospel, witnessing Christ through word and deed, and addressing the physical,
4 psychological, intellectual, and spiritual needs of others; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Reverend Glover was educated in the public schools of Bibb County, Georgia,
6 and earned bachelor's, master's, and doctor of divinity degrees from Fort Valley State
7 College, the American Baptist Theological Seminary, Mercer University School of Religion,

10 congregation of Greater Zion Missionary Baptist Church 35 years ago; and
- 11 WHEREAS, over the past three decades leading Greater Zion Missionary Baptist Church,

13 the spiritual and educational growth of the church and the surrounding community; and
- 14 WHEREAS, whether the task is preparing a sermon, visiting the sick, counseling the
15 troubled, baptizing a new believer, or acting as a theologian, educator, administrator, or
16 humanitarian, Reverend Glover serves as a shining example of God's righteous path; and
- 17 WHEREAS, the unmatched spiritual assistance offered by Reverend Glover is a source of
18 strength and direction for persons in all walks of life and from all economic strata; and
- 19 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this enduring example of God's message
20 of peace and love be recognized and congratulated for his innumerable good works rendered
21 on behalf of persons in need.
