A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Dr. Beverly A. Williams Glover; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Dr. Beverly A. Williams Glover has long been recognized by the citizens of this
3 state for the vital role that she has played in leadership and her deep personal commitment
4 to the education of the students of Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, Dr. Glover is a native of Macon, Georgia; attended Savannah State, Fort Valley
6 State, Georgia College, and Georgia Southern University; and earned a doctoral degree in
7 administration and supervision from Nova Southeastern University; and

8 WHEREAS, she is the director of alternative education for Bibb County schools, working
9 diligently to ensure performance and achievement for all students; and

10 WHEREAS, Dr. Glover began her distinguished career in the field of education as a teacher
11 with the Bibb County Public School System and has served as a home-school facilitator,
12 counselor, assistant principal, and principal; and

13 WHEREAS, Dr. Glover is an active leader at Greater Zion Missionary Baptist Church, where
14 her husband has served as pastor for 35 years and she is a member of the deaconess ministry,
15 Sunday school, missionary society, mission-in-action, and advisor to the women's ministry;

17 WHEREAS, she is past president of the Georgia Association of Ministers' Wives and
18 Ministers' Widows, past basileus of the Epsilon Tau Zeta Chapter of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority,
19 past director of protocol and faculty member of the International Association of Ministers'
20 Wives, and a member of OES #82, Phi Delta Kappa, the NAACP, Church Women United,
21 National Council of Negro Women, and Macon Chapter of the Links, Inc.; and

22 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the extraordinary accomplishments of
23 this distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
25 commend Dr. Beverly A. Williams Glover for her sacrifice, foresight, accomplishment, and
26 contributions on behalf of education in Georgia and recognize the positive influence she has
27 had upon the lives and futures of countless young people in this state.
