A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Reverend Taffi Dollar in honor of Women's History Month;
2 and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Reverend Taffi Dollar is a world-renowned author, teacher, conference speaker,
4 and theologian; and

5 WHEREAS, Reverend Dollar is united in love and marriage to her husband, Creflo, and
6 together, the couple leads the congregation of World Changers Church International (WCCI)
7 and World Changers Church – New York; and

8 WHEREAS, with over 30,000 members and located in College Park, Georgia, WCCI stands
9 as a beacon of hope, striving to spread the Word of God and serve as a place of fellowship
10 for the congregation and surrounding community; and

11 WHEREAS, Reverend Dollar serves as the president and CEO of Arrow Records, a
12 cutting-edge Christian record company, and founded Prestige Ministry, an outreach to
13 women in the adult entertainment industry; and

14 WHEREAS, her commitment to improving the lives of others can be seen through her work
15 as founder of WCCI Women's Ministry, which promotes unity and sisterhood through Bible
16 study meetings, retreats, workshops, and other empowering events; and

17 WHEREAS, she is passionate about educating the future leaders of this state, serving as a
18 mentor with the Service to Education Program at Toney Elementary School in Decatur and
19 founding the Ethel Johnson Bolton High School Seniors Scholarship Program, which has
20 awarded 20 scholarships to Atlanta's high school seniors; and

21 WHEREAS, as a minister of the Gospel, Reverend Dollar has shown the energy, devotion,
22 and commitment truly reflective of divine guidance which has allowed the Word of God to
23 spread throughout the community; and

24 WHEREAS, she ministers throughout the country, and her services can be seen world wide
25 on the *Changing Your World* television broadcast; and

26 WHEREAS, she was selected to be a speaker on the topic of faith and clergy for Women's
27 History Month; and

28 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this enduring example of God's message
29 of peace and love be recognized and congratulated for her innumerable good works rendered
30 on behalf of persons in need.
