- 8 Service Medal, the United Nations Service Medal, the National Defense Service Medal, the
- 9 Korean Presidential Unit Citation, and the Republic of Korea War Service Medal; and
- 10 WHEREAS, members of his family, including his brother, Rufus Wiggins, his sister, Evelyn
- Wiggins Banks, and his niece, Linda Wright, still reside in Coffee County and often share
- memories of their childhood spent swimming and playing in the river; and
- 13 WHEREAS, in honor of his life and dedicated service and supreme sacrifice for our nation,
- 14 it is only fitting and proper that a lasting memorial be established.
- 15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 GEORGIA that this body joins in honoring the service of SGT Harold Wiggins and dedicates
- 17 the bridge on US 441 South, past Memorial Gardens, as the SGT Harold Wiggins Memorial
- 18 Bridge.
- 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
- 20 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the SGT Harold Wiggins
- 21 Memorial Bridge.
