## A RESOLUTION

4 a proud tradition of excellence in swimming and diving with equal emphases on character  
5 and academics; and

6 WHEREAS, the Lady Trojans brought home their fourth consecutive GHSA Class AAAAA  
7 State Championship title, while the boys team placed fourth in the state finals; and

8 WHEREAS, this year's team of talented swimmers included Amanda Abbott, Sammie  
9 Bosma, Daniel Bridgers, Zach Bunner, Kim Carducci, Hannah Clark, Alli Crenshaw, Drew

13 WHEREAS, the phenomenal performance of the team is a clear indication of the outstanding  
14 athletic ability, the dedication and hard work, and the unity of purpose and spirit of each  
15 member of the team; their superb swimming and diving talents; and the astute direction of  
16 Head Coach Glenn Meeden, Assistant Coach Theresa Mullan, and Community Coach Kayla  
17 Fillingim; and

18 WHEREAS, the Lady Trojan 200 yard medley team broke the Georgia state record with a  
19 time of 1:45.01 and included Sammie Bosma for the backstroke, Shannon O'Malley for the  
20 breaststroke, Jordan Drake for the butterfly, and Kim Carducci for the freestyle; and

21 WHEREAS, the girls 400 yard freestyle relay team placed first in the state, Shannon  
22 O'Malley won the state title in the 100 yard breaststroke, Kim Carducci placed second in the

23 state for the 100 yard freestyle, and Sammie Bosma won first in the state for the 100 yard  
24 backstroke and the 100 yard freestyle; and

25 WHEREAS, the boys 200 yard freestyle relay team finished third in the state and the boys  
26 400 yard freestyle relay placed second; and

27 WHEREAS, from the boys team, Jimmy Yoder placed third in the state for the 200 yard  
28 freestyle and second in the state for the 500 yard freestyle; and

29 WHEREAS, this magnificent team performed with precision during the season and earned  
30 its well-deserved reputation for high standards of athletic achievement and the stiff  
31 competition which it presented its opponents.

32 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
33 the members of this body commend the Lassiter High School swim and dive team for its  
34 unparalleled achievements and invite them to be recognized by the House of Representatives
