A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending George "Trey" Howell Grindley III; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, George "Trey" Howell Grindley III has attained the rank of Eagle Scout, the
3 most distinguished rank conferred by the Boy Scouts of America; and
- 4 WHEREAS, a candidate for the most exceptional award in scouting must complete a
5 rigorous program of training and demonstrate his proficiency in selected scouting techniques
6 and attainment of the highest ideals of scouting; and
- 7 WHEREAS, only one scout out of 97 ever reaches this lofty level of achievement, and Trey
8 has ably evidenced his aptitude and competency in mastering the various special skills taught
9 through the Boy Scout program; and
- 10 WHEREAS, this hard-working young man is a member of Troop 89 and has demonstrated
11 great leadership skills and initiative during his years with the Boy Scouts of America
12 program; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Trey has further refined his leadership skills by serving as the Senior Patrol
14 Leader of Troop 89, attending the Greenbar Leadership Camp and the Ultimate Scouting
15 Experience of 2010, and trekking across the country to the Philmont Scout Reservation in
16 New Mexico where he backpacked for 90 miles; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Trey is schooled at home through The Classical School, participates in JROTC,
18 and runs cross-country with The Kings Academy; and
- 19 WHEREAS, to earn the rank of Eagle Scout, Trey greatly improved and expanded the disc
20 golf course in Cobb County's Oregon Park by adding concrete pads and benches to many of
21 the holes; and

22 WHEREAS, an outstanding Georgian, Trey has truly exhibited a commitment to the scouting
23 principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a manner
24 becoming an Eagle Scout; and

25 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader
26 is an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young man's future.

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
28 the members of this body commend George "Trey" Howell Grindley III for his diligence and
29 dedication in pursuing the highest honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and
30 congratulate him on attaining the prestigious rank of Eagle Scout.
