

House Bill 375 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act creating the Montgomery County Board of Commissioners approved
2 February 27, 1953 (Ga. L. 1953, p. 2729), as amended, particularly by an Act approved April
3 12, 1982 (Ga. L. 1982, p. 4115), so as to provide for staggering of terms of office for
4 commission districts; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
5 purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 An Act creating the Montgomery County Board of Commissioners approved February 27,
9 1953 (Ga. L. 1953, p. 2729), as amended, particularly by an Act approved April 12, 1982
10 (Ga. L. 1982, p. 4115), is amended by revising Section 5 as follows:

11 "SECTION 5.

12 Members of the board representing Commissioner Districts 1, 2, and 3 shall be elected at
13 the November general election in 2012, take office the first day of January immediately
14 following that election, and serve for initial terms of office of four years and until their
15 respective successors are elected and qualified. Members of the board representing
16 Commissioner Districts 4 and 5 shall be elected at the November general election in 2012,
17 take office the first day of January immediately following that election, and serve for initial
18 terms of office of two years and until their respective successors are elected and qualified.
19 All future successors to members of the board whose terms of office are to expire shall be
20 elected at the November general election immediately preceding the expiration of such
21 terms, take office the first day of January immediately following that election, and serve
22 for terms of office of four years and until their respective successors are elected and
23 qualified."

SECTION 2.

25 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
