AS PASSED SENATE

**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT**

1 To amend an Act relating to the school system of the City of Savannah and Chatham County,
2 approved March 21, 1968 (Ga. L. 1968, p. 2636), as amended, particularly by an Act
3 approved May 28, 2010 (Ga. L. 2010, p. 3637), so as to remove certain qualifications for
4 local board of education members; to restore terms of office for board members to four-year
5 staggered terms; to provide for submission of this Act for approval under the federal Voting
6 Rights Act of 1965, as amended; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:**

8 **SECTION 1.**

9 An Act relating to the school system of the City of Savannah and Chatham County, approved
10 March 21, 1968 (Ga. L. 1968, p. 2636), as amended, particularly by an Act approved
11 May 28, 2010 (Ga. L. 2010, p. 3637), is amended by striking subsection (c) at the end of
12 Section 2 which reads as follows:

13 "(c)(1) No person shall be eligible for election as a member of the board who has not been
14 a resident of the election district which such person seeks to represent for at least 12
15 months.

16 (2) No person who does not possess a high school diploma or a general educational
17 development (GED) diploma shall be eligible for election to the board.

18 (3) This subsection shall be applicable to persons elected or reelected in elections held after
19 July 1, 2010."

20 **SECTION 2.**

21 Said Act is further amended by revising Section 3 to read as follows:

22 **"SECTION 3.**

23 (a) The president of the board of education in office on January 1, 2010, shall serve out the
24 remainder of the term to which he or she was elected, such term expiring on December 31,

25 2010. At the general election in 2010, the president shall be elected pursuant to this Act
26 and shall serve for a term of two years and until his or her successor is elected and qualified
27 and shall take office on January 1, 2011. At the general election in 2012, the president
28 shall be elected pursuant to this Act and shall serve for a term of two years and until his or
29 her successor is elected and qualified and shall take office on January 1, 2013. At the
30 general election in 2014 and every four years thereafter, the president shall be elected
31 pursuant to this Act and shall serve for a term of four years and until his or her successor
32 is elected and qualified and shall take office on January 1 immediately following his or her
33 election. No president shall serve for more than eight consecutive years.

34 (b) The members of the board of education in office on January 1, 2010, representing
35 Education Districts 1, 2, 3, and 7 shall serve out the remainder of the terms to which they
36 were elected, such terms expiring on December 31, 2010. At the general election in 2010,
37 members of the board shall be elected from Education Districts 1, 2, 3, and 7 pursuant to
38 this Act and shall serve for a term of two years and until their successors are elected and
39 qualified and shall take office on January 1, 2011. At the general election in 2012 and
40 every four years thereafter, members of the board shall be elected from Education Districts
41 1, 2, 3, and 7 pursuant to this Act and shall serve for terms of four years and until their
42 successors are elected and qualified and shall take office on January 1 immediately
43 following their election.

44 (c) The members of the board of education in office on January 1, 2010, representing
45 Education Districts 4, 5, 6, and 8 shall serve out the remainder of the terms to which they
46 were elected, such terms expiring on December 31, 2012. At the general election in 2012,
47 members of the board shall be elected from Education Districts 4, 5, 6, and 8 pursuant to
48 this Act and shall serve for a term of two years and until their successors are elected and
49 qualified and shall take office on January 1, 2013. At the general election in 2014 and
50 every four years thereafter, members of the board shall be elected from Education
51 Districts 4, 5, 6, and 8 pursuant to this Act and shall serve for terms of four years and until
52 their successors are elected and qualified and shall take office on January 1 immediately
53 following their election.

54 (d) All primaries and elections under this Act shall be held in accordance with Chapter 2
55 of Title 21 of the O.C.G.A., the 'Georgia Election Code.'

56 **SECTION 3.**

57 It shall be the duty of the attorney of the Board of Public Education for the City of Savannah
58 and the County of Chatham to submit this Act for approval pursuant to Section 5 of the
59 federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended.

SECTION 4.

61 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
