A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Subpart 2 of Part 1 of Article 16 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of
- 2 Georgia Annotated, relating to compulsory attendance for students in elementary and
- 3 secondary education, so as to enact "Jessie's Law"; to provide for a definition; to provide that
- 4 foster care students are credited as present to attend court proceedings relating to such
- 5 students' foster care; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 6 purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

9 This Act shall be known and may be cited as "Jessie's Law."

SECTION 2.

- 11 Subpart 2 of Part 1 of Article 16 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 12 Annotated, relating to compulsory attendance for students in elementary and secondary
- 13 education, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 14 "<u>20-2-692.2.</u>
- 15 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'foster care student' means a student who is in
- a foster home or otherwise in the foster care system under the Division of Family and
- 17 <u>Children Services of the Department of Human Services.</u>
- 18 (b) A foster care student who attends court proceedings relating to the student's foster care
- shall be credited as present by the school and shall not be counted as an absence, either
- 20 excused or unexcused, for any day, portion of a day, or days missed from school."

21 SECTION 3.

22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
