The House Committee on Judiciary offers the following substitute to HB 102:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 2 of Chapter 3 of Title 9 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to specific periods of limitations of actions, so as to provide a limitation period with
- 3 respect to civil actions for title by prescription or private way by prescription to real property
- 4 that is subject to a recorded conservation easement; to provide for definitions; to provide that
- 5 such actions shall be barred entirely under certain circumstances; to exempt certain utility
- 6 facilities from the limitation periods; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Article 2 of Chapter 3 of Title 9 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 10 specific periods of limitations of actions, is amended by adding a new Code section to read
- 11 as follows:
- 12 <u>"9-3-30.3.</u>
- 13 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'conservation easement' shall have the same
- meaning as provided in Code Section 44-10-2.
- 15 (b) Any civil action for title by prescription or private way by prescription to any real
- property that is subject to a conservation easement which is unlimited in duration and
- which has been recorded in accordance with Article 1 of Chapter 10 of Title 44, the
- 18 'Georgia Uniform Conservation Easement Act,' shall be brought not later than July 1, 2015,
- or four years after the recording of the conservation easement, whichever date occurs last;
- 20 provided, however, that such an action shall be barred entirely if title by prescription or
- 21 private way by prescription did not ripen prior to the recording of such conservation
- 22 <u>easement.</u>
- 23 (c) Subsection (b) of this Code section shall not apply to any civil action for the purpose
- of acquiring an easement or private way by prescription by an electric membership
- 25 <u>corporation, a municipality operating a municipal electrical system, or a public utility</u>
- 26 <u>corporation under the regulatory jurisdiction of the Public Service Commission.</u>"

27 **SECTION 2.**

28 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
