7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Code Section 48-8-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to exemptions from
- 9 sales and use tax, is amended by revising paragraph (86) as follows:
- 10 "(86) For the period commencing on July 1, 2007, and ending on June 30, <del>2011</del> <u>2013</u>,
- the sale or use of engines, parts, equipment, and other tangible personal property used in
- the maintenance or repair of aircraft when such engines, parts, equipment, and other
- tangible personal property are installed on such aircraft that is being repaired or
- maintained in this state so long as such aircraft is not registered in this state;"

15 SECTION 2.

16 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
