12 Whitney M. Young, Jr., Service Award and the Silver Beaver Award, the Atlanta Area
13 Council's award for service; and

14 WHEREAS, Mr. Stewart has served with honor and distinction with the Boy Scouts of
15 America program, and his vision and unyielding commitment will be sorely missed upon the
16 occasion of his retirement; and

17 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
18 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
20 commend Mr. Jimmy Stewart for his efficient, effective, unselfish, and dedicated public
21 service to the Boy Scouts of America program and recognize March 14, 2011, as Jimmy
