

ADOPTED

Senators Tippins of the 37th and Rogers of the 21st offered the following amendment:

1 *Amend the Senate Public Safety and Homeland Security Committee substitute to SB 138 (LC*
2 *35 2194S) by replacing lines 17 through 24 as follows:*

3 in Code Section 40-5-21. An applicant for a tag renewal shall swear that such person is in
4 possession of a valid Georgia driver's license or Georgia identification card and shall
5 include the applicant's driver's license or identification card number in the renewal, whether
6 such renewal is accomplished in person, by mail, or electronically. Any person who
7 knowingly makes any false statement in executing an application for tag renewal shall be
8 guilty of false swearing, whether or not an oath is actually administered to the applicant,
9 if such statement shall purport to be under oath. Upon conviction of such offense, such
10 person shall be punished for false swearing as provided by Code Section 16-10-71. A tag
11 agent shall include the affirmation required by this subsection on the renewal notice form
12 to be returned by the applicant or completed by the applicant online with an appropriate
13 space for the applicant to sign the statement and provide his or her driver's license or
14 identification card number."
