A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 48-8-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 exemptions from sales and use tax, so as extend for a limited period of time an exemption
- 3 with respect to sales of tangible property used for and in the renovation or expansion of a
- 4 zoological institution; to provide for procedures, conditions, and limitations; to provide an
- 5 effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Code Section 48-8-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to exemptions from
- 9 sales and use tax, is amended by revising subparagraph (A) of paragraph (87) as follows:
- 10 "(87)(A) Notwithstanding any provision of Code Section 48-8-63 to the contrary, from
- July 1, 2009, until June 30, 2011 <u>2013</u>, sales of tangible personal property used for and
- in the renovation or expansion of a zoological institution."

SECTION 2.

- 14 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 15 without such approval.

SECTION 3.

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
