## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending the Lilburn Woman's Club; and for other purposes.

3 education, home life, international outreach, and public issues; and
- 4 WHEREAS, the club offers support to programs and projects that benefit the local  
5 community, arranges social events for members and guests, and encourages study,  
6 participation, and enjoyment of the arts; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the club uplifts the lives of local children through mentoring programs, annual  
8 scholarship awards, the donation of books, and its Spring Into Art annual elementary school  
9 art show; and
- 10 WHEREAS, members of the club donate their time, talent, and energy to others by providing  
11 meals to cancer survivors, hosting annual dances for the mentally and physically challenged,  
12 raising money for holiday gifts for needy families, organizing the Lilburn Farmer's Market,  
13 and helping to maintain the grounds at Lilburn's historic Wynne Russell House; and
- 14 WHEREAS, the club has supported relief outreach efforts in Honduras and Haiti through  
15 volunteer service and the donation of over the counter medicines, hygiene items, vitamins,  
16 and children's toys; and
- 17 WHEREAS, with over 50 active members, the club's influence is far reaching and the  
18 Lilburn community as a whole benefits from the numerous contributions of this charitable  
19 organization; and
- 20 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding work of this fine  
21 organization and its numerous contributions to the citizens of this state be appropriately  
22 recognized.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
24 the members of this body commend the Lilburn Woman's Club on its outstanding  
25 contributions to the City of Lilburn and the State of Georgia.
