A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 48-5-7.4 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to bona
- 2 fide conservation use assessment of property for ad valorem tax purposes, so as to provide
- 3 that certain use of property for collection and conversion of solar energy shall not constitute
- 4 a breach of a conservation use covenant for purposes of said Code section; to repeal
- 5 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Code Section 48-5-7.4 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to bona fide
- 9 conservation use assessment of property for ad valorem tax purposes, is amended in
- 10 subsection (p) by adding a new paragraph to read as follows:
- 11 "(5.1) Allowing part of the property to be used for the collection of solar energy and
- 12 <u>conversion of the same into heat or electrical energy by means of solar energy collection</u>
- panels, for use of such converted energy on-site or transmission and use off-site by the
- property owner or any other person, if the primary use of the property continues to be the
- good faith production of agricultural products from or on the land;"

SECTION 2.

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
