Senators Hill of the 4th and Mullis of the 53rd offered the following amendment:

1 *Amend the Senate Transportation Committee substitute to SR 343 (LC 34 3028S) by adding*
 2 *between lines 183 and 184 the following:*

PART VIII-C

4 WHEREAS, Kermit Yates was a prominent citizen of the City of Cobbtown in Tattnall
 5 County, Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, Mr. Yates moved to the City of Cobbtown in the 1930s and departed this life
 7 on October 26, 1995, after a long career as a mechanic and noted member of the Cobbtown
 8 community; and

9 WHEREAS, he was the mayor of Cobbtown for many years; he was in charge of the city's
 10 water department and was one of the founders of the water system; and

11 WHEREAS, he was also very active in the Sunlight Primitive Church, where he served as
 12 a deacon and was also the caretaker for the church cemetery; and

13 WHEREAS, since Mr. Yates was a mechanic, he kept everyone "running" by working on
 14 cars, trucks, and tractors; and

15 WHEREAS, it is only fitting and proper that a lasting memorial to this outstanding public
 16 servant and community leader be established.

17 *By adding between lines 213 and 214 the following:*

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this body desires to honor Mr. Kermit Yates by
 19 dedicating a portion of SR 152 from the city limits of Cobbtown, Georgia, to the Coleman
 20 Bridge as the Kermit Yates Memorial Highway.
