14 North Habersham Sixth Grade Academy in Demorest, Georgia; and
- 15 WHEREAS, an outstanding Georgian, Sam has truly exhibited a commitment to the scouting
16 principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a manner
17 becoming an Eagle Scout; and
- 18 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader
19 is an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young man's future.
- 20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
21 commend Samuel Perry Herrin for his diligence and dedication in pursuing the highest honor

22 awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on attaining the prestigious
