A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Glenn Shrum, Harrison High School's 2011 STAR Student; and for other
2 purposes.

12 obtained the highest score in one administration of the new three-part Scholastic Aptitude

15 a STAR Teacher that has inspired and encouraged them throughout their high school career;

17 WHEREAS, Glenn chose as his STAR teacher Harrison High School educator Mr. Joe
18 League, who provided support and guidance throughout the years and encouraged Glenn to
19 achieve his utmost potential; and

20 WHEREAS, Glenn has personified the selfless dedication, mental agility, verbal adroitness,
21 and personal maturity necessary for superlative academic performance; and

22 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia looks with great anticipation toward the future of this
23 bright and promising young citizen.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
