A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Foster Care Support Foundation; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Foster Care Support Foundation is a nonprofit organization located in Roswell,
3 Georgia, with the mission of enriching the lives of Georgia's foster children and helping to
4 acquire and retain qualified and caring foster parents; and

5 WHEREAS, this compassionate and successful foundation was established by Rachel Ewald
6 to strengthen the ability of foster families to meet the needs of their foster children; and

7 WHEREAS, Foster Care Support Foundation serves a vital and growing need throughout the
8 State of Georgia by providing free clothing, infant equipment, and developmental toys to
9 thousands of foster children each year; and

10 WHEREAS, the foundation partners with Georgia's Department of Family and Children
11 Services for child verification, foster parent recruiting, and foster parent training; and

13 and companies with both financial support and the donation of new and slightly used items;

15 WHEREAS, thousands of dedicated and generous volunteers ensure the foundation's goal
16 of uplifting the lives of children in Georgia's foster care system; and

17 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding work of this fine
18 organization and its numerous contributions to Georgia's foster children be appropriately
19 recognized.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
21 recognize Foster Care Support Foundation for the selfless service it provides to countless
22 children in foster care and the families that support them.
