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The House Committee on Governmental Affairs offers the following substitute to SB 121:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 12-2-24, Article 2 of Chapter 5 of Title 14, Code Section 27-1-13,
- 2 and Code Section 52-7-5 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to, respectively,
- 3 powers and duties of the Board of Natural Resources, corporation commissioner, disposition
- 4 of funds received by the Department of Natural Resources, appropriations, and grants and
- 5 donations for natural resources conservation camps, and numbering of watercraft vessels, so
- 6 as to provide for refunding of fees under certain circumstances; to amend Code
- 7 Section 12-2-23 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to officers, meetings,
- 8 quorum, compensation of members of the Board of Natural Resources, and reimbursement
- 9 of members for expenses, so as to provide for travel expense reimbursement for members of
- 10 the Board of Natural Resources; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and
- 11 for other purposes.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

13 SECTION 1.

14 Code Section 12-2-23 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to officers, meetings, quorum, compensation of members of the Board of Natural Resources, and 15 reimbursement of members for expenses, is amended by revising subsection (d) as follows: 16 17 "(d) The members, including the chairman <u>chairperson</u>, shall each receive the per diem prescribed in Code Section 45-7-21 for each day of actual attendance at official meetings 18 of the board, or any committee thereof, and; shall be reimbursed for travel expenses, 19 20 <u>lodging</u>, <u>meals</u>, <u>and transportation</u> at the legal mileage rate when traveling in the service 21 of the board by personal vehicle, and in addition to mileage shall be reimbursed for actual 22 expenses incurred by reason of tolls and parking fees; and shall be reimbursed for actual 23 costs of travel by public carrier same rates established in the travel regulations for state 24 employees. The members, including the chairman chairperson, while on committee 25 assignment approved in advance by the chairperson, shall receive \$25.00 per diem; actual 26 cost of expenses, including meals, lodging, and transportation; and 10¢ per mile for

transportation by private means to the place of service and home by the nearest practicable

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route the same per diem and reimbursement of travel expenses as those authorized for attendance at meetings. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Code section, the total per diem compensation paid in any year to any member of the board shall not exceed \$1,200.00 \$3,000.00. Such per diem and actual expense shall be paid from funds of the department."

33 SECTION 2.

34 Code Section 12-2-24 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to powers and

- 35 duties of the Board of Natural Resources, is amended by revising subsection (a) as follows:
- 36 "(a)(1) The Board of Natural Resources may make such rules and regulations as it may
- deem advisable to govern the work of the department and the duties of its employees
- 38 under this title.
- 39 (2) Without limiting paragraph (1) of this subsection, the board may establish, by rule
- 40 <u>or regulation, a procedure to refund fees collected in error or overpayment or to which</u>
- 41 the department or state is not otherwise entitled."

42 SECTION 3.

- 43 Article 2 of Chapter 5 of Title 14 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 44 corporation commissioner, is amended by revising Code Section 14-5-21, relating to fees and
- 45 reports, as follows:
- 46 "14-5-21.
- 47 All fees collected by the Secretary of State shall be paid into the state treasury for the use
- of the state, and the Secretary of State shall include in his or her annual reports a full
- statement of all fees collected or received under Chapters 2 through 5 of this title and the
- disposition thereof. The Secretary of State shall be authorized to establish, by rule or
- 51 regulation, a procedure by which his or her office shall refund fees collected in error or
- 52 overpayment or to which the state is otherwise not entitled."

SECTION 4.

- 54 Code Section 27-1-13 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to disposition of
- 55 funds received by the Department of Natural Resources, appropriations, and grants and
- donations for natural resources conservation camps, is amended by revising subsection (a)
- 57 as follows:
- 58 "(a) All funds resulting from the operation of the department and from the administration
- of the laws and regulations pertaining to wildlife, excluding fines, but including all license
- 60 fees and other income (except that income provided for in subsection (b) of this Code
- section), shall be paid into the general funds of the state treasury; and each year at least

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62	such amount shall be appropriated to the department. The board shall be authorized to
63	establish, by rule or regulation, a procedure to refund fees collected in error or
64	overpayment or to which the department or state is otherwise not entitled."

65 SECTION 5.

- Code Section 52-7-5 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to numbering of watercraft vessels, is amended by adding a new subsection to read as follows:

 "(o) The board shall be authorized to establish, by rule or regulation, a procedure to refund fees collected pursuant to this chapter which were collected in error or overpayment or to
- which the department or state is otherwise not entitled."
