- 13 WHEREAS, to earn the rank of Eagle Scout, Robert built a structure that provided shelter
14 and shade to teachers at Blandy Hills Elementary School as they monitored students'
15 playground activities; and
- 16 WHEREAS, a Brotherhood member of the Order of the Arrow, Robert has served as senior
17 patrol leader, patrol leader of his Cobra Patrol, and troop quartermaster; and
- 18 WHEREAS, an outstanding Georgian, Robert has truly exhibited a commitment to the
19 scouting principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a
20 manner becoming an Eagle Scout; and

21 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader
22 is an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young man's future.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
24 commend Robert Aaron Sweat for his diligence and dedication in pursuing the highest honor
25 awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on attaining the prestigious
