A RESOLUTION

- 1 Urging efforts to promote an increase in public awareness of the dangers of celebratory
- 2 gunfire; urging state and local governments and law enforcement agencies to better educate
- 3 Georgians regarding the serious threat created by firing a weapon into the air during a
- 4 celebration; and committing to studying and adopting tougher criminal sanctions for those
- 5 who perform celebratory gunfire resulting in injury or death to another person; and for other
- 6 purposes.
- 7 WHEREAS, each year in this country there are hundreds of thousands of calls to police
- 8 emergency numbers complaining of celebratory gunfire; and
- 9 WHEREAS, during 2009 and 2010, one metro Atlanta county reported over 5,000 calls of
- 10 people discharging firearms on July 4 and December 31; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the random discharge of any firearm in populated residential areas presents an
- 12 inherent danger of injury or death to nearby citizens; and
- 13 WHEREAS, four year old Marquel Peters, who was killed by a stray bullet while sitting in
- 14 church on New Year's Day, is a tragic example of the inherent danger of celebratory gunfire;
- 15 and
- 16 WHEREAS, current laws do not sufficiently address or deter this tremendous threat to public
- safety, resulting in numerous incidents of injury, damage to property, and loss of innocent
- 18 life; and
- 19 WHEREAS, now is the time for Georgia's leaders to come together and to work together to
- 20 help prevent the senseless loss like the loss of beautiful little Marquel Peters.
- 21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 22 this body urges both governmental and private entities to promote an increased public

23 awareness of the dangers of celebratory gunfire and further urges state and local governments

- 24 and law enforcement agencies to better educate Georgians regarding the serious threat
- 25 created by firing a weapon into the air during a celebration.
- 26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, in honor of Marquel Peters, this body is committed to
- 27 studying and adopting tougher criminal sanctions for those who commit celebratory gunfire
- 28 which results in injury or death to another person.
- 29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- 30 and directed to transmit appropriate copies of this resolution to the DeKalb County Board of
- 31 Commissioners and the mother of Marquel Peters.
