A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Cadet Colonel Tiana Williams; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, a proper quality education for the young people of this state is the single most
3 important objective of the General Assembly; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Cadet Colonel Tiana Williams has shown by the example of her
5 accomplishments that the pursuit and attainment of scholastic success are within the reach
6 of the students in this state; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Cadet Colonel Williams is an extraordinary student and cadet in the Air Force
8 Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps (AFJROTC) at Mundy's Mill High School in
9 Jonesboro, Georgia; and
- 10 WHEREAS, she has served as WING Commander of the largest AFJROTC program in the
11 State of Georgia and Florida, helping to lead over 400 cadets and a program that has earned
12 the Distinguished Unit award from AFJROTC Headquarters each year since 2005; and
- 13 WHEREAS, a role model to her peers, Cadet Colonel Williams has been appointed to the
14 United States Naval Academy; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Cadet Colonel Williams has demonstrated great leadership qualities during her
16 four years at Mundy's Mill and has achieved outstanding grades in her advanced placement
17 course schedule; and
- 18 WHEREAS, she has been a member of Mundy's Mill Elite Scholars Program and Honor's
19 Society and has attended the AFJROTC Honors Camp; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Cadet Colonel Williams is active in the youth ministries at her church, where
21 she serves as a bookkeeper and teaches classes; and

22 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia looks with great anticipation toward the future of this
23 bright and promising young citizen.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
25 recognize Cadet Colonel Tiana Williams for her outstanding achievements, congratulate her
26 upon her acceptance to the United States Naval Academy, and extend best wishes for her
