**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT**

1 To amend an Act entitled "An Act to create the Henry County Governmental Services
2 Authority," approved May 6, 2005 (Ga. L. 2005, p. 4014), so as to add airport facilities
3 within the definition of the term "authority"; to modify and clarify the powers of the
4 authority; to provide for the issuance of refunding revenue bonds; to modify the investments
5 authorized for moneys of the authority; to expand the purpose of the authority to include
6 providing public airports and landing fields; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
7 purposes.

8 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:**

9 **SECTION 1.**

10 An Act entitled "An Act to create the Henry County Governmental Services Authority,"
11 approved May 6, 2005 (Ga. L. 2005, p. 4014), is amended by revising paragraph (3) of
12 Section 3 as follows:

13 "(3) 'Project' means roads, streets, and bridges necessary or convenient for efficient
14 surface transportation in Henry County, Georgia, and any other political subdivision of
15 the State of Georgia located within Henry County, Georgia. Such term also means and
16 includes public airports and landing fields for the use of aircraft, related buildings and
17 structures, and facilities, buildings, and structures usual or convenient to be located at or
18 co-located with such undertakings; extensions and improvements of such facilities; and
19 the acquiring of necessary or convenient property, both real and personal, so as to assure
20 the efficient and proper development, maintenance, and operation of such airports and
21 landing fields deemed by the authority to be necessary, convenient, or desirable for the
22 operation of such airports and landing fields anywhere within or for Henry County."

23 **SECTION 2.**

24 Said Act is further amended by revising paragraph (4) of Section 4 as follows:

SECTION 6.

58 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
