4 school, who tragically died on October 5, 2010; and

5 WHEREAS, in her short life, Miracle touched her community through her acts of kindness

8 left us too soon, and the Miracle's Mile event serves to pay tribute to the memory of these
9 dear children and provide support for their families; and

10 WHEREAS, Miracle's parents, Winston and Sandra Williams, wish to thank the community
11 for the support they received in their hour of grief and to help other families remember the
12 lives of their children; and

13 WHEREAS, the Miracle's Mile event is an opportunity for communities to come together
14 in a spirit of love, compassion, and togetherness, and the day shall be marked as one of
15 remembrance, celebration, and healing in order to forever keep the love and memories of our
16 children in our hearts.

18 the members of this body honor the life and memory of Miracle Parham Williams and
19 commend her family on their efforts to promote remembrance and strength through the
