## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 2 of Chapter 26 of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to licensed practical nurses, so as to require fingerprint record checks for applicants
- 3 for licensure as a licensed practical nurse; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting
- 4 laws; and for other purposes.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Article 2 of Chapter 26 of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 8 licensed practical nurses, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 9 "43-26-36.1.
- Any applicant for licensure under this article shall have satisfactory results from a
- 11 <u>fingerprint record check report conducted by the Georgia Crime Information Center and</u>
- 12 <u>the Federal Bureau of Investigation, as determined by the board. Application for a license</u>
- under this article shall constitute express consent and authorization for the board or its
- representative to perform a criminal background check. Each applicant who submits an
- application to the board for licensure agrees to provide the board with any and all
- information necessary to run a criminal background check, including, but not limited to,
- 17 <u>classifiable sets of fingerprints. The applicant shall be responsible for all fees associated</u>
- with the performance of such background check."

19 SECTION 2.

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
