A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life and memory of Dr. Katheryn "K.M." Vernethea Middleton Brown; and for
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens
4 with the passing of Dr. Katheryn Vernethea Middleton Brown on February 13, 2011; and

5 WHEREAS, Dr. Brown was born on June 13, 1921, in Charleston, South Carolina, a beloved
6 daughter of the late Margaret E. Wheaton Middleton and Reverend Jesse E. Middleton, Sr.;

8 WHEREAS, educated in the public schools of Charleston, Dr. Brown earned a bachelor's
9 degree from Allen University, master's degrees from Cornell University and Atlanta
10 University, and doctoral degrees from Ball State University and Atlanta University; and

11 WHEREAS, Dr. Brown dedicated 44 years to uplifting the lives of students as an educator,
12 teaching biology and horticulture at Booker T. Washington, Henry McNeal Turner, and
13 Frederick Douglass high schools in Atlanta and serving as assistant principal at Walter F.
14 George High School; and

15 WHEREAS, this highly respected educator was known for being a tough, firm, yet fair
16 teacher and was a formidable force for the students who had the opportunity to learn from
17 her; and

18 WHEREAS, a woman of deep and abiding faith, Dr. Brown was an active in the African
19 Methodist Episcopal Church and belonged to Atlanta's Cosmopolitan AME Church; and

20 WHEREAS, Dr. Brown was united in love and marriage to the late Hasell David Brown, Sr.,
21 and was blessed with the support of her children, Hasell and Michele Brown; and

22 WHEREAS, in addition to her children, she leaves behind many who will cherish her
23 memory, including her stepgrandchildren, Daniel M.D. Brown and Michael and Sheila
24 Obleton; and her siblings, Ernest and Thelma Middleton, Adele M. Weathers, Rose S.
25 Middleton, and Mabel Middleton; and

26 WHEREAS, she gave inspiration to many through her high ideals, morals, and deep concern
27 for her fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding she demonstrated to
28 her family and friends were admired by others; and

29 WHEREAS, she was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
30 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness and, by the example she made of her life,
31 she made this world a better place in which to live; and

32 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous woman, Dr. Brown will long be remembered for
33 her love of family and friendship, and this loyal mother, grandmother, sister, and friend will
34 be missed by all who had the great fortune of knowing her.

35 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
36 join in honoring the life and memory of Dr. Katheryn Vernethea Middleton Brown and
37 express their deepest and most sincere regret at her passing.
