A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Mr. Roy Everett; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Mr. Roy Everett has been recognized for his talent and sportsmanship with
3 induction into the National Tractor Pullers Association's Pulling Hall of Fame; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Mr. Everett began pulling tractors in 1972 with a Case 970 and his first pick up
5 truck pulling effort was a broken down fertilizer truck with a 350 cubic inch Chevy in 1977;

- 7 WHEREAS, an active leader of the pulling community, Mr. Everett has served as a delegate
8 on the board of directors for the Georgia Tractor Pullers Association with the National
9 Tractor Pullers Association; and
- 10 WHEREAS, he won his first NTPA Region IV championship with his famed 1967 Chevrolet
11 called The Doerunner and went on to win four point championships in NTPA's Region IV;

- 13 WHEREAS, Mr. Everett was one of the first FWD Truck pullers to utilize the aluminum
14 Rodeck block in 1982 and was the first to win at the famed Indy Super Pull with a FWD
15 Truck; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Mr. Everett is united in love and marriage to his supportive wife, Connie, and
17 he has been blessed with two remarkable sons, Tony and Paul; and
- 18 WHEREAS, in 2008, Mr. Everett's son Tony brought the famed Doerunner out from
19 retirement to win the Region IV title, with Mr. Everett serving as crew chief for his son; and

20 WHEREAS, Mr. Everett is among the finest pullers the State of Georgia has ever produced
21 and his induction into the National Tractor Pullers Association's Pulling Hall of Fame is an
22 honor befitting of his talent.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
24 commend Mr. Roy Everett on his incredible career as a puller and congratulate him upon his
25 induction into the National Tractor Pullers Association's Pulling Hall of Fame.
