## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Mexican Consul General Salvador De Lara; and for other  
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, there is a bond of friendship between the citizens of Georgia and Mexico, and  
4 the people of Georgia welcome opportunities to grow our already deep relationship at all  
5 levels, including cultural, academic, and business; and

6 WHEREAS, Consul General Salvador De Lara has long been recognized for his role in  
7 leadership and his deep personal commitment to fostering diplomatic relationships with  
8 countries around the world; and

9 WHEREAS, a native of Mexico City, Consul General De Lara earned a degree in economics  
10 from the National Autonomous University of Mexico, a master's degree from the New  
11 School for Social Research, and has completed various graduate studies with prestigious  
12 national and foreign institutions; and

13 WHEREAS, Consul General De Lara represents Mexico in Georgia, Alabama, and  
14 Tennessee, and has vast experience in the public sector and within international  
15 organizations; and

16 WHEREAS, he has worked in the Mexican Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the Presidential  
17 Office, the Ministry of Programming and Budget, the Ministry of Fisheries, and the Mexican  
18 Foreign Service; and

19 WHEREAS, Consul General De Lara has served as Counselor and Minister for Economic  
20 Affairs in the Embassy of Mexico, Director-General for Inter-parliamentary Relations, and  
21 General Coordinator of International Affairs and Protocol of the Senate; and

22 WHEREAS, he has taught at the Matias Romero Institute for Diplomatic Studies, the  
23 Anahuac University, the Center of Teaching and Research in Economics, the National  
24 Autonomous University of Mexico, and the Autonomous Technological Institute of Mexico;

26 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the extraordinary accomplishments of  
27 this distinguished gentleman be appropriately recognized.

28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
29 hereby recognize the special friendship between Georgia and Mexico and express our  
30 appreciation to Salvador De Lara, the Consul General of Mexico, for his efforts to promote  
31 peace and grow commercial, cultural, and educational ties between our two nations.
