Senators Brown of the 26th and Chance of the 16th offered the following amendment:

1 *Amend HB 274 by inserting after "waste management;" at the beginning of line 4 the*
2 *following:*

3 to change certain provisions relating to permits for municipal solid waste landfill sites within
4 two miles of a significant ground-water recharge area;

5 *By redesignating Sections 2 through 6 as Sections 3 through 7, respectively, and inserting*
6 *after Section 1 the following:*

SECTION 2.

8 Said part is further amended by revising Code Section 12-8-25.2, relating to permits for
9 municipal solid waste landfill sites within two miles of a significant ground-water recharge
10 area, as follows:

11 "12-8-25.2.

12 No permit shall be issued for a new municipal solid waste landfill, nor shall any
13 modification of a permit for an existing municipal solid waste landfill be granted for the
14 purpose of vertical or horizontal expansion of such landfill, if any part of the proposed or
15 existing site is within two miles of an area that has been designated by the director as a
16 significant ground-water recharge area unless ~~such~~:

17 (1) Such municipal solid waste landfill or expansion thereof will have a liner and
18 leachate collection system and meets any other requirements as may be established by
19 rules and regulations of the board or pursuant to other geological considerations as may
20 be determined appropriate by the director; and

21 (2)(A) The completed application for such permit or modification was submitted prior
22 to the effective date of this paragraph; or

23 (B) The completed application for such permit or modification is submitted on or after
24 July 1, 2016."
