### A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Elizabeth Ashlyn Ethridge; and for other purposes.

15 percent of her class, and has a cumulative grade point average of 4.44; and

17 National Honor Society, a member of the Beta Club and the varsity soccer team, and was a  
18 participant in the executive internship program, the peer mentoring program, and several  
19 plays, dramas, and musicals; and

21 the Mount Paran Christian School Timothy Award, and was a nominee for the 2011 Comcast  
22 Leaders and Achievers Scholarship Program; and
