#### A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the Georgia Work Ready program and commending Mr. Joe Bush, the  
2 Governor's Office of Workforce Development's 200,000th Work Ready Georgian; and for  
3 other purposes.

4 WHEREAS, Georgia Work Ready was launched in August of 2006 by Governor Sonny  
5 Perdue and the Georgia Chamber of Commerce to improve the job training and marketability  
6 of Georgia's workforce and drive future economic growth for this state; and

7 WHEREAS, Georgia Work Ready is the only initiative of its kind to be conducted through  
8 a partnership between a state government and state chamber of commerce, ensuring that  
9 companies can more reliably match the right people with the right jobs; and

10 WHEREAS, by identifying both the needs of business and the available skills of Georgia's  
11 workforce, this state can more effectively generate the right talent for the right jobs; and

12 WHEREAS, Mr. Joe Bush has been selected as the Governor's Office of Workforce  
13 Development's 200,000th Work Ready Georgian; and

14 WHEREAS, Mr. Bush works as a line supervisor at WIKA Instrument Corporation in  
15 Lawrenceville, Georgia; and

16 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding work of the Georgia  
17 Work Ready program and its numerous contributions to the citizens of this state be  
18 appropriately recognized.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
20 the members of this body commend the outstanding service that the Georgia Work Ready  
21 program provides to Georgians and recognize Mr. Joe Bush as the 200,000th Work Ready  
22 Georgian.
