

ADOPTED

Senators Seay of the 34th, Mullis of the 53rd and Stoner of the 6th offered the following amendment:

1 *Amend the Senate Transportation Committee substitute to HB 156 (LC 34 3051S) by*
 2 *inserting after "employees;" on line 4 the following:*
 3 to honor and provide for state highway safety employees injured or killed in the line of duty;
 4 to amend Article 1 of Chapter 6 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
 5 relating to general provisions relative to uniform rules of the road, so as to dedicate the
 6 Georgia Move-Over law in memory of Spencer Pass, a HERO operator with the Georgia
 7 Department of Transportation who was tragically killed in the line of duty;

8 *By inserting between lines 7 and 8 the following:*
 9 Article 1 of Chapter 6 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
 10 general provisions relative to uniform rules of the road, is amended by revising Code Section
 11 40-6-16, relating to procedure for passing stationary authorized emergency vehicles,
 12 stationary towing or recovery vehicles, or stationary highway maintenance vehicles, by
 13 adding a new subsection (a), by redesignating subsections (a) through (c) as subsections (b)
 14 through (d), respectively, and by amending the newly designated subsection (d) as follows:
 15 "(a) This Code section shall be known and may be cited as the 'Spencer Pass Law.'
 16 "~~(c)~~(d) Violation of subsection ~~(a)~~ (b) or ~~(b)~~ (c) of this Code section shall be punished by
 17 a fine of not more than \$500.00."
