A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Mary R. Domahidy, Ph.D.; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Mary R. Domahidy, Ph.D., has long been recognized for the vital role that she
3 has played in academic leadership and her deep personal commitment to the welfare of the
4 citizens of every community she has served; and

5 WHEREAS, she has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of her time,
6 talents, and energy toward the betterment of her community and the educational system of
7 this nation as evidenced dramatically by her superlative service in the field of public policy
8 studies; and

9 WHEREAS, she earned a Bachelor of Arts degree from Vanderbilt University in 1967 and
10 a Master of Arts degree in urban affairs in 1978 and a Ph.D. in public policy analysis in 1990
11 from Saint Louis University; and

12 WHEREAS, Dr. Domahidy has published extensively, served in numerous professional and
13 university services, and received many awards including the 2004 Saint Louis University
14 Faculty Woman of the Year, the 2001 Saint Louis University YWCA Leadership Award, and
15 she was a participant in the Leadership Exchange Program with the Royal Thai Government
16 through the University of Missouri Outreach and Extension program in 1998 and 2000, as
17 well as the recipient of the 1996 Governor's Award for Excellence in Teaching; and

18 WHEREAS, Dr. Domahidy has served with honor and distinction at Saint Louis University
19 as a professor in the Department of Public Policy Studies from 1992 to 2009 and as Director
20 of the Center for Service and Community Engagement where her vision and unyielding
21 commitment continues to set the standard for public service; and

22 WHEREAS, Dr. Domahidy's significant organizational and leadership talents, her
23 remarkable patience and diplomacy, her keen sense of vision, and her sensitivity to the needs

24 of the academic community have earned her the respect and admiration of her colleagues and
25 associates; and

26 WHEREAS, she is a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation for
27 integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and

28 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
29 remarkable and distinguished scholar, professor, and administrator be appropriately
30 recognized.
