- 4 WHEREAS, Dr. Sadri is a 1986 graduate of Life University School of Chiropractic in
5 Marietta, Georgia, where he is an extended faculty member; and

22 Who's Who National Registry, and was selected as one of America's Top Chiropractors in
23 2006 by the Consumer's Research Council; and

25 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
