SECTION 1.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 Code Section 43-33-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to definitions
7 relative to the "Georgia Physical Therapy Act," is amended by revising paragraph (7) as
8 follows:

9 "(7) 'Physical therapy' means the examination, treatment, and instruction of human 10 beings to detect, assess, prevent, correct, alleviate, and limit physical disability, bodily 11 malfunction and pain from injury, disease, and any other bodily and mental conditions 12 and includes the administration, interpretation, documentation, and evaluation of tests and measurements of bodily functions and structures; the planning, administration, 13 14 evaluation, and modification of treatment and instruction, including the use of physical 15 measures, activities, and devices, for preventative and therapeutic purposes, including but not limited to dry needling; and the provision of consultative, educational, and other 16 advisory services for the purpose of preventing or reducing the incidence and severity of 17 18 physical disability, bodily malfunction, and pain."

SECTION 2.
