A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Reverend Charles E. Wright; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Reverend Charles E. Wright has demonstrated his commitment to teaching the
3 Gospel, witnessing Christ through word and deed, and addressing the physical,
4 psychological, intellectual, and spiritual needs of others; and
- 5 WHEREAS, a native of North Carolina, Reverend Wright was called by the Lord to preach
6 the Word while attending First Baptist Church in Roanoke Rapids and relocated his family
7 to Tennessee to attend Tennessee Temple College; and
- 8 WHEREAS, he served as pastor of Peoples Baptist Church of Atlanta for 22 years, helping
9 the church grow in size and influence to uplift the community like the light of Bethlehem and
10 serve as a spiritual leader and place for fellowship; and
- 11 WHEREAS, during his decades of leadership at Peoples Baptist Church, Reverend Wright

- 14 WHEREAS, since his retirement as pastor of Peoples Baptist Church, Reverend Wright has
15 relocated to Max Meadows, Virginia, where he continues to travel and preach as the Lord
16 opens doors; and
- 17 WHEREAS, whether the task is preparing a sermon, visiting the sick, counseling the
18 troubled, baptizing a new believer, or acting as a theologian, educator, administrator, or
19 humanitarian, Reverend Wright serves as a shining example of God's righteous path; and
- 20 WHEREAS, the unmatched spiritual assistance offered by Reverend Wright is a source of
21 strength and direction for persons in all walks of life and from all economic strata; and

22 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this enduring example of God's message
23 of peace and love be recognized and congratulated for his innumerable good works rendered
24 on behalf of persons in need.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
26 commend Reverend Charles E. Wright on his years of dedicated service to the Lord and
27 extend best wishes for many more years of successful fellowship and leadership.
