

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO INTRODUCE LOCAL LEGISLATION

Notice is hereby given that there will be introduced at the 2011 session of the General Assembly of Georgia a bill to amend Henry County Ordinance No. 2-2-18, codified at Ga. Laws, 1974, P. 3680, Act. No. 1323, § 2A; Ga. Laws 1982, P. 3638, Act. No. 880, § 1, by adding language that will allow for a balanced election cycle for Henry County Board of Commissioners, so as to provide that effective January 1, 2013, Commission District III will be changed temporarily to a two (2) year term, for one election cycle and thereafter, revert to a four (4) year term for all future successors to be elected during the same election cycle as Commissioner Districts IV and V; to provide an effective date; repeal conflicting law; and for other purposes.
